

Exclusion from Nursery / Club due to Infectious/Communicable Diseases Policy

In order to ensure the limitation of spreading infectious diseases we ask you to please follow the guidelines from public health Wales available on the following link:

If a member of staff feels that your child may have symptoms suggesting any of these diseases/ infections then we may ask you to come and collect your child from nursery and/or seek medical advice.

Should the Nursery / club Manager or Deputy consider the illness / situation to warrant immediate medical attention, the emergency services will be contacted to take the child directly to Hospital and the parent / carer notified accordingly.

Children suffering with a high temperature or generally unwell we ask you to please keep at home. If a child has a temperature whilst in nursery / club the parent / carer will be notified immediately.

Children who just have a cough or cold may attend the nursery / club depending on the severity of the individual case. Children showing signs of teething will be allowed in nursery with appropriate agreements in place for soothing and medication them through teething.

If your child has not been his / her normal self at home but is not showing signs of illness when brought to nursery/ club, please mention it to the staff and let them know how best to contact you throughout the day.

We are able to give children Calpol if feeling a little unwell with permission from the parents being given on a medicine form on the app, calpol must belong to your child, if you do not have a supply here we will ask you to bring it in.

Prescription medication can be given for ongoing needs please see our medication policy for more information.

Children who are sick or have diarrhoea whilst at the nursery/ club are to be collected immediately and kept away for 48 hours following the last instance of sickness or diarrhoea.
